FIFTY YEARS AGO, 1959 - At the February meeting, movies were shown and there was a large turnout in spite of the snow and cold. The movies gave new members a chance to see what the club did in years past.

FORTY-FIVE YEARS AGO, 1964 - The annual dance had 174 paid admissions, giving the club a total of \$259.00. After expenses, which included 5 half-barrels of beer, a case of soda, the band, one bartender, and the hall rental, the club ended up with a profit of \$90.00.

FORTY YEARS AGO, 1969 - From the Wheeling the "A" Newsletter - Wisconsin Chapter MAFCA, Volume XIV Issue 2, February, 1969: If you find a mistake on these pages, please consider that it was put there for a purpose. We try to publish something for everyone, and some people are always looking for mistakes.

THIRTY-FIVE YEARS AGO 1974 - My First Retirement by Gary Koser -

Since most people look forward to retirement, I'm feeling somewhat odd. Being only 23 and already retired is unusual. Leaving the Board of Directors does not mean an end of activities in the chapter. Yet, missing the Board meetings, the planning, and the working relationships will let me know I am officially retired. FIFTEEN YEARS AGO, 1994 - We served up the idea of funding a computer purchase. Profits generated by the sale of our own Wisconsin Chapter cookbook. Response was overwhelming to this idea. Now it's up to our over 400 Wisconsin Chapter families to submit recipes.

TEN YEARS AGO, 1999 - "The Best of Wes" went on sale for \$4.25. Wes Campbell was a Chapter member/cartoonist who for 24 years drew Babbit Banter cartoons for Wheeling the "A".

FIVE YEARS AGO, 2004 - The annual Ice Cream Social and election was well attended as usual, and for good reason.
