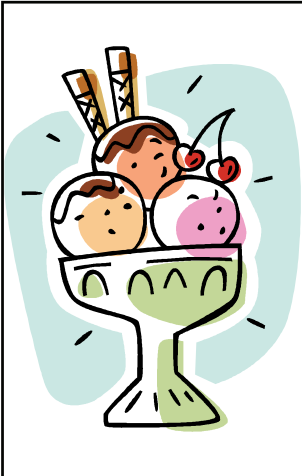

Dave Boucher called the meeting to order at 1:53 PM with pledge of allegiance.

President – Dave B. – Dave thanked everyone for coming and asked if there were any new members present. The club received a thank you note from the Honor Flight group for our donation. We also got a thank you note from the AMVets for our participation in the Milwaukee Veterans Day Parade. MAFCA is offering five free memberships to club members who have not been a member previously. All the club accessories have been sold, we received \$110.00 from the sale. Dave B. asked if there were any further nominations for the board of directors. There were none from the floor so nominations were closed. The 2014 board will have six members. MAFFI is doing a drawing within each club for a brick at the Gilmore Museum. 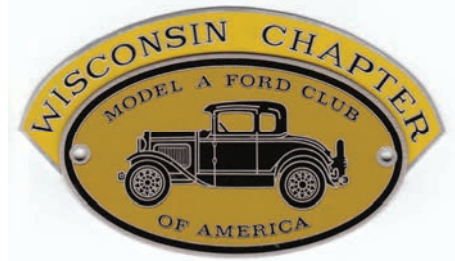

Chassis building continues at tech meet

Work on building Model A chassis continued at the November tech meet.

Club member Roger Olsen lead the effort as members installed front and rear springs and front and rear axles onto the previously bare Model A chassis.

Various club members stepped forward to install the components. We learned how to use spring spreaders for the front and rear springs and how to install front and rear spring shackles that hold the front and rear axles to the springs.

Among the club tools available to all club members are front and rear spring spreaders if you will be working on your own suspension.

At the tech meet we also learned that some of the holes for the cotter pins in the reproduction fasteners were apparently drilled off center, since we were unable to push cotter pins all the way through the bolts once the castle nuts were in place. The holes will have to be re-drilled through the bolts. *Continued on next page.....*

Once the axles were in place, club member Al Downs was given the task of cleaning up an old set of brake backing plates for reuse on the chassis.

Our next tech meet is 7 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 16. We will be installing brakes on the chassis.

We'll continue work on the frame at the Feb. 20 and March 20 meets. The tech meets are at Mail Truck Model A Parts is at 8509 South Howell Ave., Oak Creek.

Bring a chair and join us. As always there will be plenty of food and drink.

Delineator June, 1929

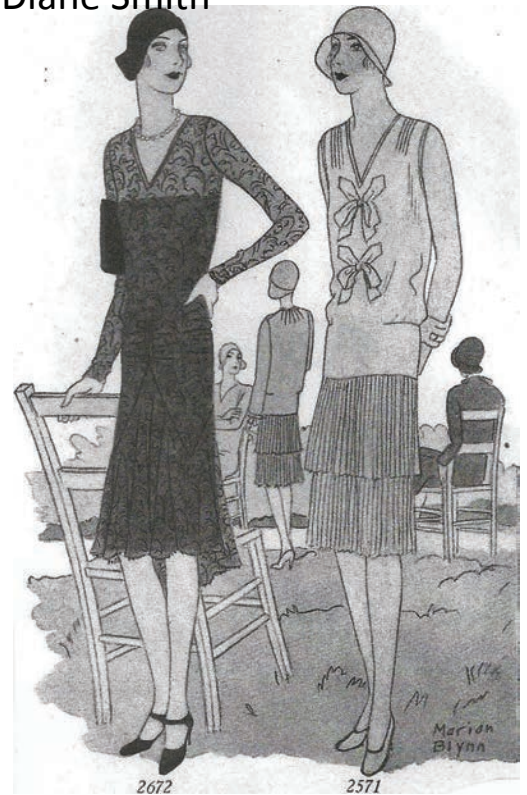

The Loveliness of Lace

2672-The great chic of this formal afternoon frock lies in its fabric, black lace, the most formal of afternoon fabric of all, and in its silhouette. It has the princess line, molded at the waistline by vertical shirring at the center back and front and the sides. At the knees it flares. The flare is two-piece, longer in back and attached in points. Shirred sleeves.

This is a Perfect Grandstand Frock

2571-Here is the perfect example of the spectator sports frock for which flat crepe is the smart fabric. It is simple, with formal details. Two bows, that seem to be laced through in the Chanel manner, are really applied. The plaited tier skirt is attached below a very flat hip-line and there are no sleeves, no belt, no collar.



A Dark Frock for too Bright Days

2679-Thin black with its cool, dark surface is very chic and restful to look at on a hot, bright day. Revers of egg-shell crepe turn back on the surplice closing of this frock and there is a flared tier running diagonally around the skirt, high on the left, low on the right side. It is a beltless dress, draped and bow-tied.

This Costume has Many Claims to Chic

2674-First it is one of the dressmaker ensembles, and they are so simple to make as they are smart, for the details are soft- there is no tailoring-and the coats are usually unlined. Then, it has this year's important short jacket, blousing above a wide hip-band that ties in a bow. The frock beneath is sleeveless, with a one-piece skirt set in wide box-plaits and attached in an upward curving line to the plain crepe body. A bow of the check is tied through slashes. The frock is without a belt, but it has a snug hip-line. This ensemble may be more formal by making it of plain flat crepe and fagoting it at the hem-line, on the cuffs and down the front of the jacket. It would be chic, too, in plain crepe de Chine, with a blouse in a small floral or geometric print or in another shade or color.

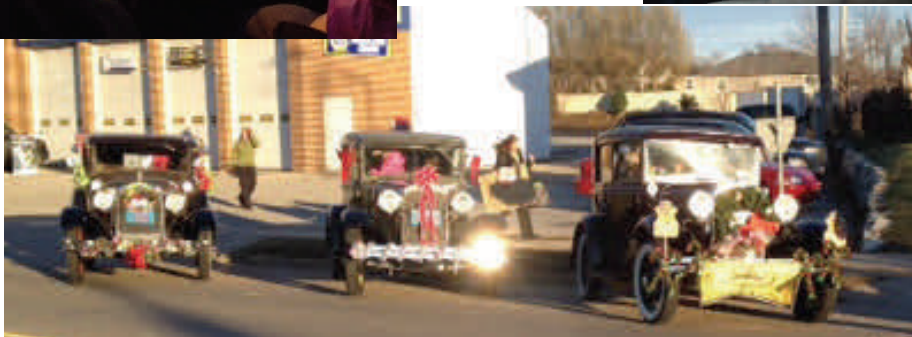
Looking back in the rearview mirror.....

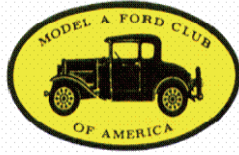
