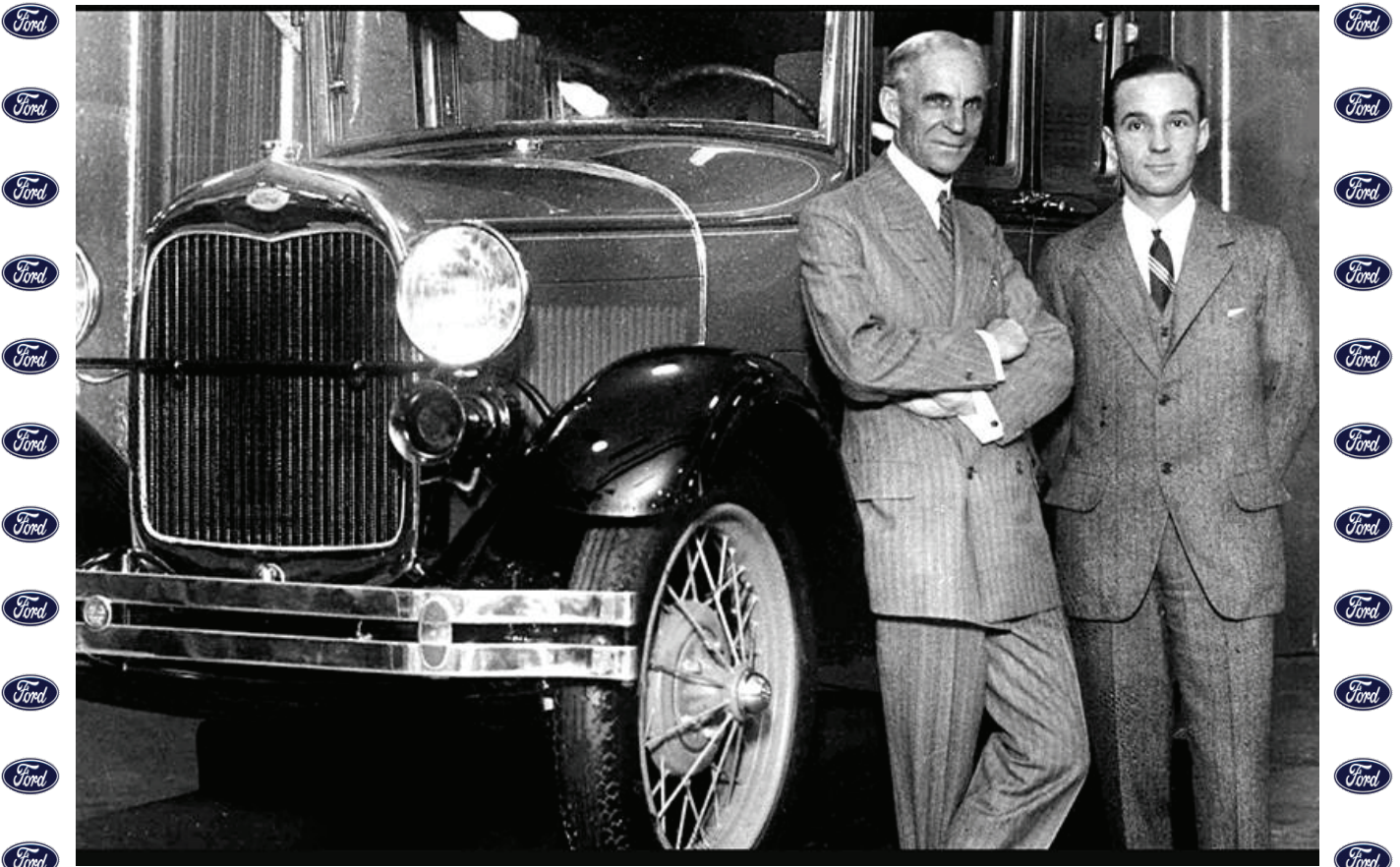

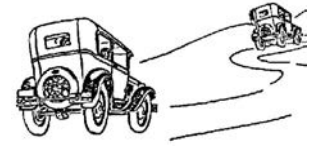

# 'A' Trip Back to Our Beginning 1956

*From the Sunday March 11, 1956 Milwaukee Journal by Emil Schneider (note: I took the liberty to paraphrase)*

Henry Ford's indestructible Model 'A' is on the rise again. Many of the Model 'A' worshippers are members of the rapidly growing organization known as the Model A Restorers Club. It quite possibly is destined to become one of the largest auto clubs in the nation. Current membership is about 1,800.

Members include a judge in Georgia, a banker in Grand Rapids, Mich., and an undertaker in Puerto Rico. The president and founder of the club, William Hall is the motor vehicle inspector for the state of Georgia.

In Wisconsin, which does not yet have a local chapter, the unofficial headquarters are in the backyard of Garford S. Schulze. Schulze hopes to start a Wisconsin Chapter in the near future. At a recent meeting of model 'A' owners at Schulze's home 15 of the 30 who attended said they wanted to join. Model 'A' enthusiasts will gather at the La Follette school, 720 S. 92<sup>nd</sup> street on April 8 to organize a Wisconsin Chapter of the Model 'A' Restorer's Club. The first President was Demo Staver, Treasurer was Joe Komar, Vice President was Stan Schulze, Secretary was Karl Grassberger.

It was all of our intentions from the beginning to form a club which was Democratic in nature and belonging to No One but the Members themselves for their mutual enjoyment while participating in a great and rewarding hobby. – Demo Staver, President

The model 'A' is a natural to restore said Schulze. It's less expensive to rebuild than most other cars of by-gone days. The average cost of restoring an 'A' to factory newness is about \$1000 he said. If most of the rebuilding is done by the owner the cost can be cut to \$600 or \$700.

*Included in the March 1956 newsletter was a catalog from Gaford Schulze's Model 'A' parts business. Examples with prices include: Kingpin set - \$5.00, Front spring - \$6.00, Rebuilt Generator - \$8.00, Wheel, primed - \$8.50, Running Boards - \$18.00, Doors, used - \$6.00.*



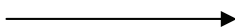
