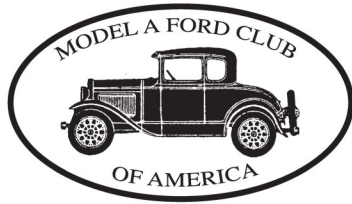

July 23rd-24th-25th, 2021

This Model "A" Reunion is the greatest gathering of old Fords and old Ford enthusiasts in Wisconsin. This Reunion started in 1962, and is sponsored by four clubs: Central Wisconsin Chapter MARC/MAFCA, Nickle A Region MARC, Wisconsin Chapter MAFCA, and the Wisconsin Region MARC.

The meet consists of a weekend of enjoying Model A's and Model A fellowship, and includes a Tour around the Rapids area, People's Choice Awards, Car Games, Kids' Games, Adult Games, a Hubley Derby, Chapter Team Events, Rolling Pin Toss, a Dance, Fund-Raising Auctions, Shoe Box Swap Meet, as well as lots of surprises and fun.

The Reunion is held the last full weekend in July, unless it conflicts with a National MARC or MAFCA meet. The Central Wisconsin Chapter MARC/MAFCA hosts the reunion on their private 10-acre site, which includes a clubhouse, wooded campsites, and is close to many nice motels and restaurants.

Location: The clubgrounds are located 4 miles east of Wisconsin Rapids, or 11 miles west of Plover, just south of state Highway 54. Turn south on 72nd Street North (a dead end road). Watch for signs.

Weekend Activities

Refreshments are available throughout the weekend for registered participants.

Good Food: A potluck lunch will be held on Saturday and Sunday. Participants are asked to bring 2 dishes to pass (one for each day). Friday and Saturday evening, you may want to roast hot dogs at your campsite or go out for a relaxed dinner at one of the nearby restaurants with a group of your new friends.

Friday afternoon the registration table opens. An Auction will be held in the evening of Model A related items, as well as other donated items for the kids, ladies, and men. There will also be a corn and pizza roast. Registration does not cover cost of Pizza or Corn.

Saturday morning starts with a Shoe Box Swap Meet, Technical Seminar. This will be followed by a Ski Race then a noon potluck, and then a driving tour around the Greater Rapids area. There will also be a Slow Drive competition for the Model A's, a Hubley Derby Kids' Games and Adult Games. A dance will be held at the clubhouse for the evening's entertainment. At the dance, the winners of the Basket Raffle will be announced. Tickets for the Basket Raffle will be on sale Saturday after lunch.

Sunday is a day of Car Games, Potluck Lunch, Chapter Team Events, and a Ladies Rolling Pin Toss, followed by the awards presentation and Raffle Drawings.

Where to Stay

Primitive campsites are available on the grounds for \$15/site for the entire weekend. For an additional charge, a few sites have power, but is limited to the first 12 registered participants. 

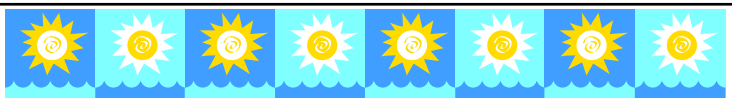

Old Business – The National Service Award recipients for 2019 were Gene and Betsy Taurman not Art and Sue Blazek.

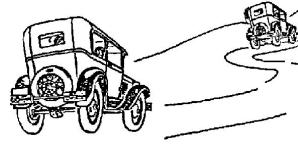
New Business – The Schmiechen's and Huenink's will be hosting the 2022 banquet. More details will follow.

CHOP AND POTATO BAKE *(Mary Gurgul, from Wi Chapter, "A" Road to Good Cooking)*

- 6 pork chops ¼ tsp. pepper
- Vegetable oil 24 oz pkg. hash browns thawed
- Seasoning salt 1 cup cheddar cheese
- 10 ¾ oz. can cream of celery soup ½ cup milk
- 2.8 oz. can Durkee French fried onions ½ cup sour cream



Brown pork chops in lightly greased skillet. Sprinkle with seasoning salt and set aside. Combine soup, milk, sour cream, pepper and ½ tsp. seasoning salt. Stir in potatoes, ½ cup cheese and ½ can French fried onions. Spoon mixture into a 9 x 13 baking dish. Arrange pork chops over potatoes. Bake, covered for 40 minutes at 350 degrees. Top with remaining cheese and onions. Bake, uncovered, five minutes longer.
