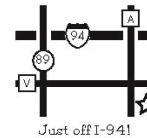

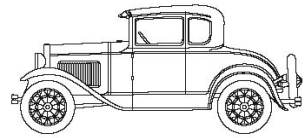

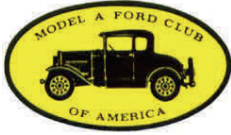

Dave Boucher called the meeting to order at 1:33 PM with pledge of allegiance.

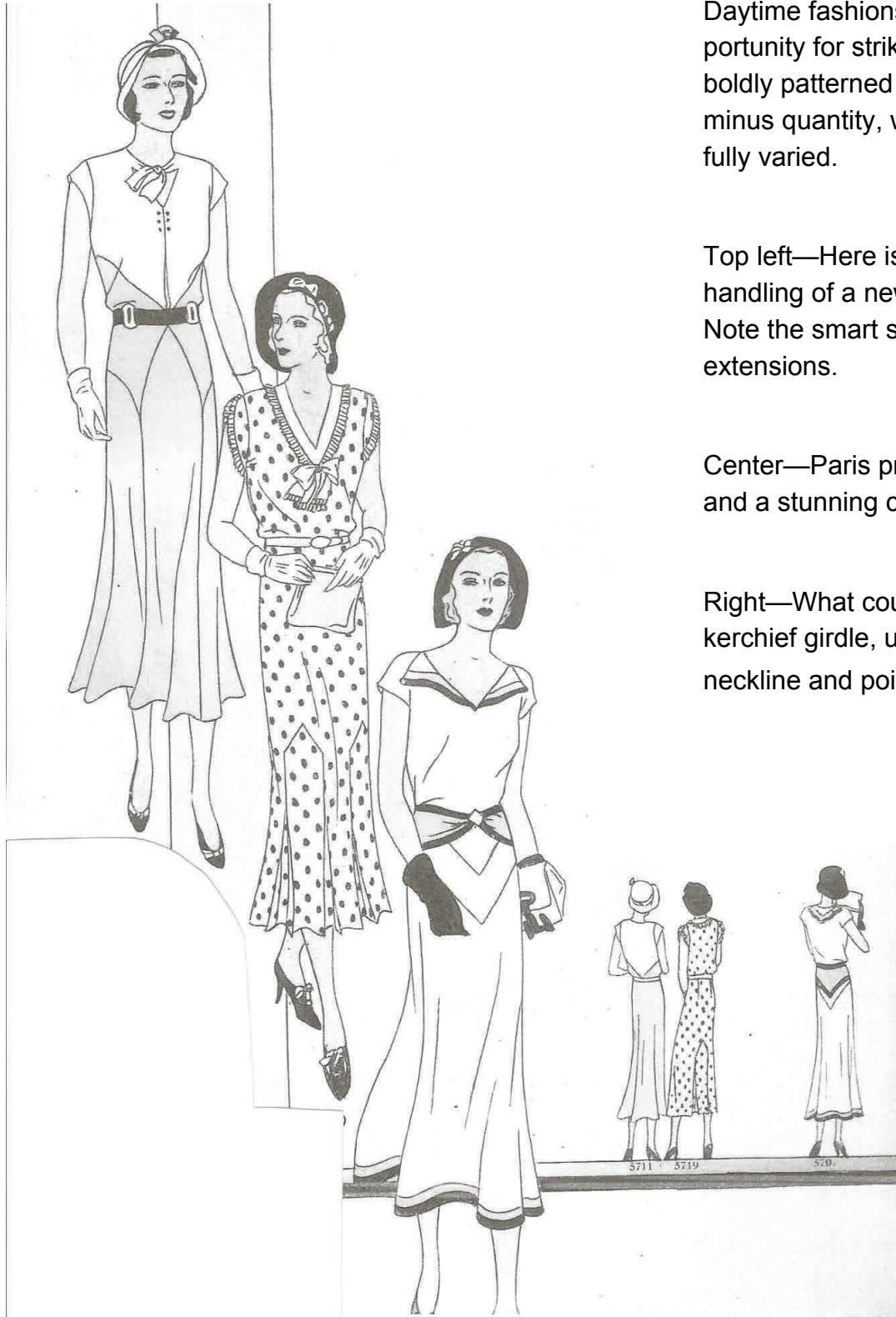

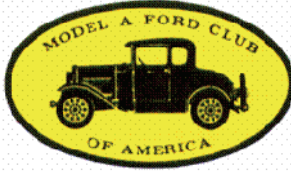
