
2007 Wisconsin Rapids Planning Meeting



We started with a chassis from a 1930 Coupe and completely restored all parts and assemblies. Antique Engines in Skokie Illinois rebuilt the engine. By October the chassis was complete.

The fenders were new and we installed the spare tire wells ourselves. We did all body and paintwork.

Nick Mazos supplied all of the Oak. Nick has a portable sawmill and a solar kiln.

We machined the rough lumber to the needed dimensions and constructed the body in our shop.

This information was inserted in the roof material on Wednesday, December 13, 2006. This was the day we installed the roofing material.

Completion is estimated to be sometime in early February 2007.






